Boghoppers Lake District Weekend 2022

A walks

John and Kate will lead an A walk on each day (**Saturday 25th June** and **Sunday 26th June**). We propose to leave the hotel at **9 am** and will decide on the proposed walks by 8 pm the evening before so that we can take account of the weather forecast. If you are joining the **A walkers** but are not staying in the hotel please meet us at the hotel in good time for a **9 am departure** or arrange a meeting time at the start of the walk. If necessary car share arrangements will allow us to minimise the number of vehicles (and car park fees) should we use cars.

- Saturday- From the Hotel, St Sunday Crag (2,756ft, 840m, W23, B32) 8.7 miles, total ascent 2,742ft We leave the back of the hotel to walk a little way into Grisedale Valley before ascending via Thornbow End to the summit 'The Cape' of St Sunday Crag. We descend to Deepdale Hause and continue down to Grisedale Tarn and walk down Grisedale valley to the hotel.
- Sunday- From the Hotel, Sheffield Pike (2,215ft, 675m, W99, B158) 9 miles, total ascent 2,210ft We cross Grisedale Valley, ascending to Lanty's Tarn to walk in Glenridding Valley, climbing past the Greenside Mine to Nick Head. We climb to the summit of Sheffield Pike, returning to Nick Head and descending via Glencoyne and Seldom Seen to Ullswater shore. Level walk back to the hotel through Glenridding village.

 8 miles, total ascent 1,767ft

The walk follows the route of the Ullswater Way to return to Aira Force.

From the hotel Lanty's Tarn, Greenside Mine and Glenridding 6 miles, total ascent 1,113ft We cross Grisedale Valley, ascending to Lanty's Tarn to walk in Glenridding Valley to Greenside Mine and then descending down Greenside Road followed by a level walk back to the hotel from Glenridding village.
